Summary of the position

The day, night or weekend patient attendant is responsible for overseeing the welfare of the clients and keeping them occupied, as well as seeing that the premises of the Centre are kept in good condition. He will also be responsible for preparing some meals and maintaining the safety rules, as well as carrying out other related duties.

Conditions and requirements

Grade 12

First Aid certificate and one year's experience

Any candidate who has had personal experience with over-consumption of alcohol and/or drugs must have 2 years of sobriety

Must be fluent in spoken and written Innu and French

Must be sensitive to, and have knowledge of, the A.A. twelve-step program, as well as Matitushan

Must have a valid driver's license and a vehicle
